AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 41606, carrying
2 State Route 3011, also known as Branch Road, over Spring
3 Creek in Lemont, Centre County, as the Private John W. Coble
4 Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Private John W. Coble Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) John W. Coble was born May 6, 1912.

11 (2) Mr. Coble was married to Sarah Josephine Coble, and
12 they had six children: William Lucas Coble, Robert Harold
13 Coble, Barbara Louise Coble Partner, Kay Frances Meleshenko,
14 John Allan Coble and Rebecca Ann Holter.

15 (3) Mr. Coble entered Naval Service on May 12, 1944, and
16 was honorably discharged from the United States Navy on
17 November 18, 1945.

18 (4) Mr. Coble was a PennDOT employee who died while on
19 the job on June 19, 1972.

1 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
2 41606, carrying State Route 3011, also known as Branch Road,
3 over Spring Creek in Lemont, Centre County, is designated the
4 Private John W. Coble Memorial Bridge.

5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
7 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

8 Section 2. Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
