AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," in primary and election expenses, further
12 providing for contributions by agents, anonymous
13 contributions and cash contributions.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. Section 1634 heading of the act of June 3, 1937
17 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is
18 amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
19 read:

20 Section 1634. Contributions by Agents; Anonymous
21 Contributions; Cash Contributions; Preselected and Prescheduled
22 Recurring Contributions.--

1 (d) It shall be unlawful for a candidate or political
2 committee to solicit from a person a preselected recurring or
3 prescheduled recurring contribution to the candidate or
4 political committee without the express and affirmative
5 agreement of the person.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
