6	Section 1. Section 2706 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.

10	<u>(i) College students</u>
11	(1) A college student who attends a college or
12	university located within this Commonwealth shall be eligible
13	for a resident hunting license if the college student:
14	(i) Has applied to an issuing agent or the
15	<u>commission.</u>
16	(ii) Provides a valid college identification card as
17	proof of enrollment.
18	(iii) Pays the issuing agent or the commission a
19	license fee and issuing agent fee as provided in section

- 1 <u>2709 (relating to license costs and fees).</u>
- 2 (2) A college student eligible under paragraph (1) may
- 3 <u>be eligible for license and fee exemptions for no more than</u>
- 4 <u>four consecutive years.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
